#### **LEED v5 Credit Contributions**

Category: Materials and Resources

Credit: MRc3 – Low-Emitting Materials (2 Points Possible)

Babcock-Davis Draft Stop Access Doors are constructed entirely of powder coated, plated or anodized metal, which LEED considers inherently non-emitting sources of VOCs.

Category: Materials and Resources

Credit: MRc4 – Building Product Selection and Procurement (5 Points Possible)

Babcock-Davis has demonstrated achievement in two criteria areas for Draft Stop Access Doors:

- *Human Health:* A published, complete Health Product Declaration (HPD) is available for [Draft Stop Access Doors](#), with full disclosure of known hazards of all substances present at or above 1,000 ppm (0.1%) and Pre-Checked for LEED. [Score: 1]
- *Circular Economy:* Babcock-Davis Draft Stop Access Doors are made of at least 98% Steel Alloy (default 25% post-consumer recycled content). [Score: Up to 1]
