- *Human Health:* A published, complete Health Product Declaration (HPD) is available for [Thermally Broken Retrofit Roof Hatches](#), with full disclosure of known hazards of all substances present at or above 1,000 ppm (0.1%) and Pre-Checked for LEED. [Score: 1]
- *Circular Economy:* Babcock-Davis Thermally Broken Retrofit Roof Hatches are constructed of at least 92% Steel Alloy (default 25% post-consumer recycled content). [Score: Up to 1]
